

## GETTING TO NOTTINGHAM

### By Plane

Nottingham is served by East Midlands Airport, which receives flights from mostly European destinations.

International travellers may want to fly to Dublin, and then take a cheap Ryanair or Aer Lingus flight to East Midlands or Birmingham airport.

London Luton airport is great for EU visitors. Luton Airport is 1.5 hours by road to Nottingham, but is well served by trains directly to Nottingham centre.

### By Train

Nottingham is mostly served by East Midlands Railway, which is the line you can take from East Midlands Airport or London Luton.

CrossCountry trains will be the route from Birmingham and the South. Northern rail will be the route from Manchester.

### By Car

The school site is located north-west of the city centre of Nottingham.

- The M1 passes close to the west of the city, the A42/M42 link to the south-west of the city, and the A1(M) to the east of the city.
- When using the M1 from the north, exit at Junction 26 and take the A610 Nuthall Road/Alfreton Road into the city.
- When using the M1 from the south, use Junction 24 and follow the A453 into the city centre.

Google maps is (mostly) your friend.

### Parking

There is limited parking available to book at the school site itself. This must be pre-booked and will be available to do so shortly. Keep an eye out for further announcements

There are a lot of car parks in Nottingham itself, and within a 30 minute walk of the venue there are free car parks, or park and ride facilities where you can use the tram or bus to get to the venue.

- Newdigate Street, Radford (Ra23), 11 min walk
- Boden Street, Radford (Ra33), 13 min walk


